Great Start Collaborative is a State/federal and foundation funded grant based organization with core responsibilities to enhance existing early childhood collaboration and coordination; engage parents, schools, business, faith-based organizations, state agencies, and other stakeholders in the planning, implementation, and coordination of services; promote community awareness of early childhood issues; and advocate for quality early childhood programs and services. The Great Start Collaborative components include: physical health care; social-emotional health care; parenting education and family support; early care and education; and basic needs, economic security and child safety in Marquette and Alger Counties for children from pre-birth through age five. It has just finished the planning stage of the grant and will be working on the implementation phase in 2010. UPHP participates in the bimonthly meetings for this organization.

MATERNAL INFANT HEALTH PROGRAMS

These are services for Medicaid pregnant women and infants provided by nurses, dieticians and social workers to help to reduce infant mortality and morbidity. The goal is to decrease social and psychological problems, health education deficits, and transportation needs to medical appointments and to aim for a healthy delivery of a health baby at full term. UPHP and the MIHP providers of the U.P. have a long standing collaborative relationship. Care coordination agreements have been made and all participate in workgroups to increase the quality of the MIHP programs.

Upper Peninsula Health Access Coalition consists of five local access coalitions that are community-based programs that enroll qualifying local residents into a system that; coordinates access to direct care services donated by primary and specialty medical care providers, diagnostic testing and/or free or reduced-cost medications from drug companies, pharmacies and physician offices; refers qualified patients into existing state and federal health care coverage programs for low income individuals, where appropriate; provides information on community resources and agencies to assist patients in making social services and health care-related connections; directs enrolled patients without a "medical home" to services that may ultimately give them access to health care providers on a regular basis to minimize non-urgent emergency room visits, and/or provides enrolled patients with educational and informational resources dealing with chronic health conditions such as asthma, diabetes, hypertension and depression.
